1. Your name goes here with your Social Security Number in the final box. This information is mandatory to file this form.
2. This address MUST BE the address of your rental location. You should not list your home address in this box.
3. In this location, you will list the dates in which you occupied during the 2017 CALENDAR year. So, if you only leased for the 2017-2018 school year, you should list 05/22 and 12/31. If you moved out in May 2017, this should read 01/01 and 5/12.
4. You will need to check this box to indicate you have completed this form yourself.

Example:

If your rent is \$800/Summer and \$2300/Semester and three total people lived in the unit for only the Summer 2017 and Fall 2017 semester, you would do the math as follows:

$$(\$800 \times 3) + (\$2300 \times 3) = \$9,300.00$$

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4c. You will fill this out with the total rent payments for the year broken down by when they were paid. Because you pay rent only by semester, you would list the payments in January, May, and September. Again, put the TOTAL AMOUNT you and ALL OF YOUR ROOMMATES paid for that semester's rent.

5. You will list here the total number of people living in your unit (you + your roommates)

6. Divide the total rent paid by the number of people in the unit to get how much rent you paid.

7. This number is always zero.

8a. List here the same value as in Number 6.

8b. This will depend on your unit. You will need to consult your lease to determine if heat is included in your rent. **It is listed on the very first page.**

**DO NOT SIGN THE BOTTOM.**

You will need to include proof of payment. If you would like a copy of your rent statement, please contact the DLK Office. You may come to the office to retrieve a copy for free.
