
## **DLKNet: Internet Guide**

In locations where internet is provided, tenants will still need to hook up a router to receive wireless internet or an Ethernet cord to connect directly to the wall. Below you will find step-by-step

instructions on connecting your internet.

1. Locate your Ethernet connection (port).



I look like a phone jack and may also be orange or yellow!



2. Use Ethernet cord to connect to port, then connect the other end to your computer or your router. If you are connecting to the router, you will need to connect to the port labeled "modem" or "switch."

3. Make sure your router is connected to an outlet and the cord properly placed in its power source.



Don't forget to put a password on your network!



4. If you are setting up a brand new router, you will need to set up your network using the included disk. All wireless networks on DLKNet must have a password set-up. Once you have set up your password, you will just need to use your computer, phone, tablet, or other device and connect to the appropriate wireless network.

If you should ever have issues connecting to a wireless network in your house/apartment, you must first try to connect your device directly to the wall before contacting DLK for repairs.
